Procedure for compensating carbon dioxide emissions via Mulanje Mission Hospital – Sustainable Livelihoods Programme

Follow four easy steps to support rural communities in Malawi!

1. Calculate your emissions via one of the online calculators, for example www.carbonfootprint.com

For travel, an easy calculator to use is: <https://sustainabletravel.org/our-work/carbon-offsets/calculate-footprint/>

2. Calculate the funds needed to offset the carbon emissions using formula A, B, or C depending on your currency.

A. € 10 x metric tonnes to offset = amount in € needed

B. £ 9 x metric tonnes to offset = amount in £ needed

C. \$ 10 x metric tonnes to offset = amount in \$ needed

3. Pay the amount needed via any of the options like PayPal on <https://www.mmh.mw/donations/>

4. Inform Mulanje Mission Hospital via director@mmh.mw of your donation

Mulanje Mission Hospital will plant 3 trees for each tonne of carbon dioxide offset. We assume a conservative survival rate of 60% for tree seedlings and rigorously monitor tree growth. You will receive a certificate for each donation.
